Types of Curriculum

- 3- Out of Institution

⇒ Similarly activities guided by institution or administered by institution and reported to institution.

⇒ A set of directions which is based on educational goals and includes;

- 1- teaching-learning strategies.
- 2- classroom activities.
- 3- Curricular & Co-Curricular Activities.

Types of Curriculum

1:- Academic activities

- i- Teaching - Learning strategies
- ii - classroom Activities, good & motivating
- iii - Changes in content
- iv - Strategies / Facilities for I.L. Strategies.
- v - Good environment
- vi - Interaction, relations, co-operation, confidence and motivation.
- vii - School management system, Teacher training.

2:- Co-academic activities

- i - Sports, Festivals
- ii - Debate, funfair, Towns
- iii - Martial arts, Skits (Dramas)
- iv - Which is in everyone's approach
- v - Flexible & Adjustment
- vi - Social Interaction.

3:- Out of Institution

- i - Hobbies
- ii - Relation - Interaction
- iii - Research, Sharing, Social relations and other things that are reported or administered by school.
